Special Guest and Speaker: Professor Jan Fook

Professor Jan Fook is an internationally renowned researcher in social work theory, research and practice. Jan is the author of numerous books on social work practice including: Practising Critical Reflection (co-authored with Fiona Gardner), Social Work: Critical Theory and Practice; and Breakthroughs in Practice: Theorising Critical Moments in Social Work (co-edited with Lindsey Napier). Jan is returning briefly to Australia and will present a one day interactive workshop on the latest ideas on critical reflection in practice.
